## ORDER VACATING HEARING DATE AND TAKING MATTER UNDER SUBMISSION

On July 9, 2019, petitioner Susan Spell filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus ("Petition") and a supporting declaration. (Docket Nos. 1-2). Between July 16, 2019 and July 19, 2019, petitioner filed multiple documents, the captions of which reflected that a hearing was scheduled before this Court on July 23, 2019. (Docket Nos. 8-10). On July 22, 2019, this Court issued an order vacating such hearing date and submitting the foregoing matters for decision. (Docket No. 11). On July 24, 2019 and July 30, 2019, petitioner filed multiple additional documents reflecting the vacated July 23, 2019 hearing date. (Docket Nos. 13-16, 19-20). In accordance with the July 22, 2019 order, no hearing was held on such date. On July 30, 2019, petitioner also filed two copies of a "Notice of Motion and Motion for Judicial Notice in Support of [Petition]" ("Motion") which reflect that the Motion is noticed for hearing before this Court on August 27, 2019 at 9:30 a.m. (Docket Nos. 17-18).

The August 27, 2019 hearing date is hereby VACATED. The matters argued in the Motion (and petitioner's multiple other submissions) are more properly considered in conjunction with the Petition itself, thus all of the foregoing matters are submitted for decision without a hearing. <u>See</u> Fed. R. Civ. P. 78; Local Rule 7-15.
