Narrative Description

On 2-8-2020 I was dispatched to 7230 Dogwood Terrace, Apartment D, in reference to a stolen vehicle complaint.

After arrival, I spoke with RP/Donna Gill, who gave the following sworn statement: Her mother is W/Sandra Ruben, and she is currently in a hospital. V/Ruben owns a white 2015 Buick Encore (bearing Florida license plate IL37AF), which was parked at 7230 Dogwood Terrace, Lot B. She is only aware of one set of keys for the vehicle, which were hanging on a wall within the residence. S/Shawn Stuller is an acquaintance, whom she recently met, was allowing him to stay at her residence for the weekend. He is not related to her or V/Ruben. No one else, aside from the two of them, were at the residence.

RP/Gill woke up in the middle of the night and realized S/Stuller was no longer at the residence, and V/Ruben's Buick Encore, along with the keys which were hanging up, were gone. S/Stuller was the only person with access to the keys. S/Stuller has never been given permission to drive the vehicle. RP/Gill indicated the vehicle had OnStar equipment, therefore, it may be able to be tracked using its GPS.

Computer records indicated the same vehicle had fled from a traffic stop earlier in the night in Century, Florida. The driver was not identified at that time.

During the time I was on scene, Deputy Angle #400 located the vehicle traveling south on U.S. 29 near its intersection with Woodland Street. Deputy Angle attempted to stop the vehicle, however, it fled from him, continuing southbound. Deputy Angle was unable to identify the driver.

I contacted an OnStar representative, who was able to provide updated locations as the vehicle continued driving through the Pensacola area. I was able to direct other deputies to the area of the vehicle. Once the deputies had sight of the vehicle, the OnStar representative disengaged the vehicle's ability to accelerate. The vehicle drove off the roadway and stopped near the wood line next to 3033 U.S. 29. The driver fled from the vehicle into the woods, where he was captured shortly thereafter by Deputy Angle. The person captured by Deputy Angle was S/Stuller. There were no other occupants within the vehicle.

A search of S/Stuller incident to arrest, resulted in the discovery of a Bank of America credit card belonging to V/Ruben, along with a "\$100" Amazon gift card in one of his pants pockets (however, it was unknown if the card still held any value).

I spoke with S/Stuller "post-Miranda" and he indicated the following: he was given permission to use the vehicle to get groceries by RP/Gill, who he has known for approximately five years. He had V/Ruben's credit card in his possession due to her being his grandmother, and managing her finances. The reason he fled from law enforcement was due to him believing his life was in danger. He indicated that he had fun during this incident and that my use of OnStar to disable the vehicle was "cheating."

I spoke with RP/Gill once again, via telephone, and she said S/Stuller's claims were untruthful. She also said she realized V/Ruben was missing at least one credit card and gift card from her bedroom, after I left the scene.

W/Lauren Harrison is the daughter of RP/Gill. She arrived on scene and took possession of the vehicle. She also said S/Stuller's claims were untruthful.

Record checks indicated S/Stuller had an active warrant for his arrest from Santa Rosa County, Florida, and his driver license had approximately 17 suspensions, to include previous listings as a Habitual Traffic Violator (which had expired).

I transported S/Stuller to the Escambia County Jail, where he was charged with Grand Theft of a Motor Vehicle (with a bond of \$2500), Knowingly Driving with a Suspended Driver License (with a bond of \$500), and Theft of a Credit Card (with a bond of \$500). His total bond was \$3500. He was given a Circuit Court date of 2-28-2020.
