FOR ALL IN-PERSON APPEARANCES. Due to the spread of COVID-19, the Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2020-197 and Superior Court Administrative Order 2021-013 requires all individuals entering a court facility to wear a face mask at all times they are in the court facility. With limited exceptions, the court will not provide face masks. Therefore, any individual attempting to enter the court facility must have an appropriate mask to be allowed entry to the court facility.
