## T. J. Herbst Mission

Let the facts be known unto all that I am **Paul John Hansen**, and that I have residency at **488 Pearl Lane, Repton, Alabama [36475]**, which is also the **principal office address** for **T. J. Herbst Mission**. I, Paul John Hansen, am a steward in the service of **God**, and I am the **Manager** chosen in conformity with the rites of **T. J. Herbst Mission**. Being the Manager in whom is vested the legal title for the property of T. J. Herbst Society, and deeming an incorporation necessary and convenient for the more effective accomplishment of the general objects of T. J. Herbst Society, I, **Paul John Hansen**, Manager, am now acting in the nature of the **Sole Incorporator** and causing such incorporation in the manner and with all of the powers now provided by law for the incorporation of churches, congregations, or societies, and such other powers as are incident and necessary for the successful performance of any or all of the objects of T. J. Herbst Society.

Therefore, I, Paul John Hansen, am exercising the powers of my office of Manager and I am hereby and herein **making** and **subscribing** these formal articles of incorporation for this spiritual society, and upon filing these Articles of Incorporation, I am exercising the powers of a **body politic** and a **corporation sole** for the purpose of acquiring, holding, or disposing of church or religious society property, **for the benefit of religion**, for works of charity, and for public worship, with official recognition by this treaty with the State of Wyoming for exercising all authority inherent in this position and office, and **acknowledging** the same before some officer authorized to take acknowledgment, and **filing** these articles in accord with Wyoming Statutes.

**T. J. Herbst Mission** is organized primarily or exclusively for spiritual purposes and for providing **spiritual benefits** and is not organized for the purpose of making a profit.

### Article I – Name, Extent, and Duration of Incorporated Office

1. This spiritual Corporation Sole is known as "**T. J. Herbst Mission**." The State of Wyoming is allowed the power of recognizing this **spiritual, nonprofit corporation sole** under **Wyoming Statutes 17-8-108 through 17-8-117**. Recognition of the right of **free exercise** of religion by T. J. Herbst Mission by the State of Wyoming is in compliance with the first article amended unto the Constitution for the united states of America. "**Free**" in this instrument, means both "*not under the legal constraint of another*" and "*without charge.*" T. J. Herbst Mission has, in accord with the statutes of the State of Wyoming, all of the *rights* and *powers* prescribed in the case of corporations aggregate; and with all of the *privileges* provided by law regarding bodies politic and religious corporations. "*Privileges.*" in this instrument, means "*the rights, powers, franchises, and immunities held against or benefited by the course of statutory law.*"
2. T. J. Herbst Mission **does not** and **will not** have members.
3. The **Title** of the man or woman occupying the incorporated office of T. J. Herbst Mission is "**Manager**." The incorporated office of T. J. Herbst Mission **continues in perpetuity** through a succession of office-holders with the same powers and the title of Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission.

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4. When the title of the office indicates a specific gender, then during the times when the office is occupied by an officer of the other gender, the officer is called by the rendering of the title in the other gender. As examples, when the title for a male office-holder is "Patriarch" or "Steward," then a Female occupant of the office is called the "Matriarch" or the "Stewardess."
5. T. J. Herbst Mission has **spiritual jurisdiction** over the members of T. J. Herbst Society throughout the state of Wyoming, the United States, the united states of America, the earth, and the universe.
6. T. J. Herbst Mission is a **Body Politic**, and a corporation sole [one office] recognized in **Wyoming Statutes Title 17, Chapter 8, section 112**. The spiritual jurisdiction of T. J. Herbst Mission is respected and protected by Wyoming state and Wyoming Statutes. T. J. Herbst Mission respects the right and power of Wyoming state for governing under Wyoming Statutes and other existing law. The Spiritual Laws of T. J. Herbst Mission do not provide for governing any man, woman, thing, or entity outside of the Spiritual Jurisdiction of T. J. Herbst Mission. When conflict exists between civil governments and T. J. Herbst Mission, the conflict is resolved peacefully within the laws of the judicial system that has original jurisdiction.
7. T. J. Herbst Mission is incorporating with the State of Wyoming as an aid in extending the spiritual jurisdiction and charities of T. J. Herbst Mission throughout the state of Wyoming, the United States, the united states of America, and the world.
8. These Articles of Incorporation for T. J. Herbst Mission are on file with the Secretary of State of the State of Wyoming for the purpose of notifying the State of Wyoming that T. J. Herbst Mission is exercising the Rights recognized and guaranteed in the first Article amended onto the Constitution for the United States and that the members of T. J. Herbst Society are existing and practicing the doctrines and tenets of T. J. Herbst Mission freely and unencumbered, with no lawful interference by any secular authorities.
9. T. J. Herbst Mission has **continual, perpetual existence**.

## **Article II – Authority of Corporation**

1. T. J. Herbst Mission is vested with legal title for all property held for the purposes, use, or benefit of the unincorporated spiritual society, "**T. J. Herbst Society**."
2. The members and properties of the unincorporated spiritual society called T. J. Herbst Society are under the authority of T. J. Herbst Mission without geographic limit.

## **Article III – The Objectives of T. J. Herbst Mission**

1. The primary purpose for the creation of T. J. Herbst Mission is the protection of the continuation of ownership and good stewardship over the property dedicated unto the benefit of T. J. Herbst Society, which may be acquired and held in the personal name of Paul John Hansen. Title will not then be divested or passed unto the heirs of Paul John Hansen upon the death of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission, but are retained for the benefit of T. J. Herbst Society and passed unto the successor-in-office of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission.

2. Upon vesting of the title for land or property in T. J. Herbst Mission as a corporation sole, such land or property is not treatable as estate of Paul John Hansen either by T. J. Herbst Society or by any other man, woman, or entity. Such land or property cannot pass as estate unto any heir of the Manager, but only unto successors-in-office of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission by operation of law, and the land or property serves the needs of T. J. Herbst Mission under the direction of T. J. Herbst Mission, thenceforth.
3. T. J. Herbst Mission is an integrated auxiliary of the unincorporated spiritual society, "T. J. Herbst Society," which is an autonomous, integrated auxiliary of the universal called-out ones who are set-apart unto God. T. J. Herbst Mission is organized and operated exclusively for spiritual, charitable, and educational purposes, no part of the net income of which inures for the benefit of any private stockholder or individual.
4. The mission of T. J. Herbst Mission is for the furtherance of the Kingdom of God and the education and assistance of men, women, and families for the purpose of reducing dependence upon public welfare and services that are a drain upon the resources of the community.
5. T. J. Herbst Mission, under the laws of God, is dedicated unto the education and service of all people who follow God.
6. T. J. Herbst Mission is dedicated in service and financial support of men and women bringing God's message of Liberty into the lives and hearts of all of mankind, wherever dispersed.
7. T. J. Herbst Mission provides shelter for people in need of protection against the elements, clothing for people who are in need of warmth, protection, and covering for modesty, food for the hungry, and drink for people with thirst.
8. T. J. Herbst Mission provides education, teaching, research, and training in the Word of God in written and spoken communication skills, in-home and community economics, family living skills, personal hygiene, agriculture and related sciences, security of mind, body, and spirit, with special emphasis upon bringing spiritual enlightenment into the lives of others.
9. T. J. Herbst Mission assists the members and friends of T. J. Herbst Society in using and enjoying any and all of God's blessings by administering compassionate mercy, benevolence, and sustenance unto all members and friends, unto adequate vitamins, minerals, medicinal plants, energies, naturopathy, homeopathy, acupuncture, reflexology, aroma therapy, natural pediatrics and midwifery, equipment, and methodologies for achieving and enhancing the health of the body, mind, soul, spirit, and emotions, as well as providing help in spoken, physical, and written form, directed toward bringing Eternal Life and peace of mind, body, and spirit unto all members and friends of T. J. Herbst Society.
10. The members of T. J. Herbst Society and the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission have the intention of living in peace and harmony with all of the laws of God and mankind. The members of T. J. Herbst Society are Spiritual Emissaries, with neutral, *in itinere*, non-engaged, immune status. The spiritual law of T. J. Herbst Society prohibits involvement in any manner in disputes, conflicts, or wars involving secular parties, including, but not limited by, nations, factions, political systems, or secular governments.

11. T. J. Herbst Mission makes no claim that God's eternal reward of salvation for the obedient believer is in any way or in any manner dependent upon membership or affiliation with T. J. Herbst Society.

## **Article IV – Office of Manager**

### **A. Appointment**

1. The first appointment into the office of Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission is made by general consensus of the members of T. J. Herbst Society based upon personal qualifications of the man or woman desiring the office of the Manager and in accord with policies and procedures found in the Book of Spiritual Law of T. J. Herbst Society.
2. The Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission serves without bond.

### **B. Naming of Successor-In-Office**

Hereafter, the current Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of designating the successor-in-office for office of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission. The default successor-in-office for the office of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission is the Scribe of T. J. Herbst Mission, when such office exists.

### **C. Powers of Successor**

Upon effective replacement of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission, the successor-in-office is vested with the title for all property of T. J. Herbst Mission, with like powers, authorities, and immunities over the same jurisdiction and under the same liabilities and obligations as the previous Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission.

### **D. Effective Date of Replacement**

1. In the event of the death or complete incapacity of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission, the effective date of replacement-in-office is the date upon which the successor Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission files in the office of the county recorder of each county wherein any of the land or property is situated, a certified copy of his or her commission, certificate or letter of election or Appointment into the office of Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission.
2. In any event *other than* the death or complete incapacity of the Manager, the effective date of replacement-in-office is the date upon which all properties and papers of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission are in the custody and control of the successor-in-office, and the successor Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission files in the office of the county recorder of each county wherein any of the land or property is situated, a certified copy of the resignation of the previous office-holder, or a copy of the certificate of death or permanent disability, along with the new officer's commission, certificate, or letter of election or appointment.

### **E. Status during periods of no office-holder**

1. In the event of a vacancy in the office of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission and there is no preparation for immediate replacement of the office-holder by the preceding Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission, the office is held in abeyance until such time as an officer is named by a majority vote of all eligible, adult members of T. J. Herbst Society, or else by ORDER of the Chief Justice of Beyt Din Hillel, upon the advice of, and in cooperation with, the general membership of T. J. Herbst Society. Beyt Din Hillel is a spiritual court that is a body politic and a corporation sole in good standing that was filed with the State of Wyoming on the first

day of the month of July in the year two-thousand-and-seven and given filing number 2007-000540171.

2. In the event of a vacancy in the office of Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission wherein the designated Successor-in-Office is not legally competent because of nonage or other legal cause, then the office is in abeyance until such time as the designated Successor-in-Office is of the age of majority or otherwise competent.
3. In preparation for the possibility of periods when the office is in abeyance, T. J. Herbst Mission designates an official Guardian or Trustee as having authority for maintaining the books and records, guarding and conserving resources, and paying all bills for T. J. Herbst Mission until such time as the Successor-in-Office is of the age of majority or otherwise legally competent.

### **Article V –Membership and Discipline**

Membership and discipline procedures are stipulated in the book of Spiritual Law and in the bylaws of T. J. Herbst Mission, whenever such bylaws exist.

### **Article VI – Spiritual Law**

#### **A. Spiritual Law for T. J. Herbst Mission**

1. The Spiritual Laws of T. J. Herbst Mission are in The Holy Bible.
2. The tools for teaching, understanding, interpreting, and implementing Spiritual Law are translations of Spiritual Law books, bible dictionaries, and concordances.

#### **B. Admonishment and Reproof**

1. All admonishment and reproof of Members of T. J. Herbst Society for conduct on the property of T. J. Herbst Mission or on missions for the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission wherever such duties are performed, is the direct responsibility of T. J. Herbst Mission under the venue and jurisdiction of the Spiritual Law of T. J. Herbst Mission.

### **Article VII – Meeting times and places**

1. T. J. Herbst Mission is a member of the association of Churches, **Spiritual Societies**, and other qualified individuals, named *A Peaceful Solution Convention*, which association has as a primary object the promotion of peace and plenty among all mankind. A Peaceful Solution Convention exists and is funded by completely voluntary donations by members, and members are not excluded out of participating in activities merely because the members are not currently donating money, or goods, or services unto the purposes and general membership of A Peaceful Solution Convention.
2. A Peaceful Solution Convention seeks the promotion of annual attendance at the appointed times and feasts named in the bible, as well as other worthy, charitable events.
3. Meeting dates, times, and places for T. J. Herbst Society are fixed by T. J. Herbst Mission, announced for the information of Members and Friends, and recorded in the archives of T. J. Herbst Society.
4. Meeting dates, times, and places for a Peaceful Solution Convention are selected by the Founder of A Peaceful Solution Convention on the advice and consent of the associates of A

Peaceful Solution Convention, and announced by email, Voice-Over-Internet, and telephone unto the members of A Peaceful Solution Convention.

### **Article VIII – Powers of Incorporated Office**

1. T. J. Herbst Mission is not a business, is not in commerce, and has no intent of making a profit like a business. Legal title for all property, land and personal, in the possession of T. J. Herbst Mission is vested in the office of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission, *in trust* for the general membership of T. J. Herbst Society. This power can only be delegated unto Trusts with T. J. Herbst Mission as the Trustee.
2. In accord with Wyoming Statutes **17-8-112**, and the prudent and necessary course of action for the betterment of those being trained for spiritual service by T. J. Herbst Mission requires that the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission has all authority for buying, holding, leasing, mortgaging, and selling land and personal property, holding liens on land and personal property as security on debts, contracting for using and delivering goods and services, and keeping all manner of accounts in banks *in his own, personal name, or in the incorporated name*, in the same manner as any free, natural person, without intervention by any secular court. The foregoing provisions of ownership and usage are restricted only in that all of the properties are held *in trust* for the use, purpose, benefit, and behoof of the members of T. J. Herbst Mission.
3. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of suing and being sued under Spiritual Law, of complaining and defending in the incorporated name, and with the same power as natural persons, has the power of appointing attorneys-in-fact.
4. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of donating money for worthy causes that are in accord with the purposes and interests of T. J. Herbst Society.
5. T. J. Herbst Mission receives gifts, bequests, grants, interests, and devises for its own use or upon trusts.
6. The Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission has, in accord with Wyoming Statutes **17-8-112**, the **power** of creating Trusts and acting as Trustee on Trusts *in his own, personal name, or in the incorporated name*. When T. J. Herbst Mission holds the **legal title** for Trust property and said property administered by T. J. Herbst Mission, as Trustee, then T. J. Herbst Mission has the **power of Assigning Equitable Title** for properties unto Trusts that are in accord with the purposes and interests of T. J. Herbst Mission, at the will and pleasure of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission. *The powers of this provision cannot be delegated.*
7. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of selling, conveying, leasing, exchanging, transferring, or disposing of all, or any part of such property in any manner other than mortgage or pledge.
8. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of acquiring and possessing, by donation, gift, bequest, devise, or purchase, and of holding and maintaining property, land, personal, and mixed, and of granting, selling, conveying, renting, or otherwise disposing of the same as may be necessary for carrying on or promoting the objects of T. J. Herbst Mission. The word "necessary," in this instrument, means "*a condition arising out of circumstances that, in the conclusion of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission, compels a certain course of action.*"
9. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of loaning money unto any members, friends, or agents of T. J. Herbst Society other than the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission and has the power of

otherwise blessing the members, friends, and agents of T. J. Herbst Society with motivational and inspirational gifts.

10. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of providing alms unto any members and friends of T. J. Herbst Society for the purpose of providing education, temporal security, or other blessings.
11. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of doing whatever is necessary for augmenting the spiritual and temporal resources of the members.
12. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of purchasing, taking, receiving, subscribing for, or otherwise acquiring, owning, holding, using, employing, selling, lending, or otherwise disposing of, and otherwise using and dealing in and with shares or other interests in or obligations on other domestic or foreign entities, whether for profit or not for profit, in the interest of and on behalf of the objectives of T. J. Herbst Society.
13. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of lending money, or leasing property for corporate purposes, investing and reinvesting funds, and taking and holding land and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned, or invested.
14. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of conducting the affairs, carrying on the operations, and having offices and exercising the powers recognized in Wyoming Statutes 17-8-108 through 17-8-117 in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or in any state of the united states of America, or in any foreign country.
15. In the administration of the affairs of T. J. Herbst Mission, the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of making and altering bylaws that are not inconsistent with these articles of incorporation. *The powers of this provision cannot be delegated.*
16. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of appointing officers and agents of T. J. Herbst Mission, including, but not limited by, attorneys-in-fact, and defining the duties and fixing the compensation for such officers, agents and/or attorneys-in-fact. *The powers of this provision cannot be delegated.*
17. The content of all Communication by and between members of T. J. Herbst Society, as well as the content of all Communication by and between the members of T. J. Herbst Society and the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission is sacred and private communication, and as such, is protected against all investigation by any means, under the internationally recognized rules that protect privileged communications.
18. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of preserving, maintaining as inviolable, and providing full protection and immunity against every molestation of any kind whatsoever for all who seek sanctuary upon the land and property of T. J. Herbst Mission. The powers of this provision extend unto all land and property that is either owned, controlled, or occupied by T. J. Herbst Mission.
19. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power, including, but not limited by, the using and enjoying of any and all of Lord's earthly blessings, and administering compassionate mercy and benevolence unto all members and friends in the form of foods, vitamins, minerals, medicinal plants, energies, naturopathy, homeopathy, acupressure, reflexology, aroma therapy, natural pediatrics and midwifery, equipment, and methodologies that are desirable for achieving and enhancing the health of the body, mind, soul, spirit, and emotions as well as providing help in

spoken, physical, and written form, directed toward bringing peace of mind unto any and all members or friends of T. J. Herbst Society.

20. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of issuing any and all permissions, certificates of membership, authority, identification, and authority for issuing any safe-conduct document that is required for bringing into fruition the goals and purposes of T. J. Herbst Society.
21. Investigations, inquiries, examinations, hearings, defaults, and decisions in all disputes arising under these articles of incorporation are under the Spiritual Law of T. J. Herbst Society, under the ministry of a forum of justice selected by the free-will consent of all parties in the dispute. When there is no meeting of the minds of the disputing parties regarding the selection of the forum of justice, the disputing parties obtain remedies under the ministry of Beyt Din Hillel, using the rules of court of Beyt Din Hillel.
22. The Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission has the duty of keeping sufficient records and documents in order that successors-in-office have adequate information on the historic events, goals, and purposes of T. J. Herbst Mission. Determinations regarding the sufficiency of record-keeping and documentation for fulfilling the requirements of these articles of incorporation is the exclusive determination by the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission.
23. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of indemnifying any officer or agent, or any person serving at the request of T. J. Herbst Mission as an officer or agent against claims, liabilities, expenses, and costs necessarily incurred by such officer or agent in connection with the defense, compromise, or settlement of any action, suit, or proceeding, civil or criminal, in which said officer or agent is made a party by reason of being such officer, or agent for or on behalf of T. J. Herbst Mission. Exceptions against the foregoing are made in relation with matters wherein said officer, or agent for or on behalf of T. J. Herbst Mission is adjudged under spiritual law of being liable for negligence or misconduct in the performance of duty unto T. J. Herbst Society, or unto T. J. Herbst Mission. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of making any other indemnification that is authorized by, and/or that is not inconsistent with the Books of Spiritual Law of T. J. Herbst Mission.
24. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of Appointing and Ordaining members of T. J. Herbst Society as Agents, Ambassadors, Clerks, Couriers, Deaconesses, Deacons, Emissaries, Judges, Matriarchs, Ministers, Pastors, Patriarchs, Scribes, Teachers, and other offices and officers for assistance in administering compassionate mercy and benevolence and the furtherance of the goals and purposes of the Kingdom of God and on behalf of T. J. Herbst Mission.
25. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of ceasing corporate activities and surrendering the corporate franchise in accord with **Wyoming Statutes 17-19-1401 through Wyoming Statutes 17-19-1440**. The Incorporator or else the successor-in-office of Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission has the sole authority for writing and implementing the articles of dissolution. *The powers of this provision cannot be delegated.*
26. Upon dissolution of T. J. Herbst Mission, all remaining assets of T. J. Herbst Mission are distributed unto existing non-profit, spiritual entities and none of the assets are distributed unto private individuals or stockholders.



27. The incorporated State of Wyoming agrees that T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of exercising all powers necessary or convenient for bringing into fruition any or all of the purposes for which T. J. Herbst Mission exists.
28. T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of amending these articles of incorporation by filing notice of such amendments with the Secretary of State of the State of Wyoming in accord with the Wyoming Statutes that are in effect on the date of the original filing of articles of incorporation by T. J. Herbst Mission.
29. Subject unto the exceptions as noted above, the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission has the power of delegating the above-designated powers at the sole discretion of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission, but cannot delegate or re-assign the fiduciary liability for the usage of any of the above-designated powers.

### **Article IX – Corporate Seal**

In accord with **Wyoming Statutes 17-8-114**, T. J. Herbst Mission has the authority of adopting an official SEAL for marking or validating official documents and submitting the corporate seal unto the Wyoming Secretary of State for filing. The SEAL can be of the embossing type, or the ink-stamp type, at the determination of the Manager.

### **Article X – Estimated Value of Property**

- A. A Notarized Declaration listing the properties and estimated values of properties that are currently being held in the name of Paul John Hansen on behalf of T. J. Herbst Mission is filed herewith in accord with **Wyoming Statutes 17-8-111(a)(iii)**.
- B. The estimated value of T. J. Herbst Mission property being held in the personal name of Paul John Hansen at the time of making these articles of incorporation is **\$839,000.00**.

### **Article XI – First officer, Date of Incorporation, etc.**

#### **A. First appointed officer**

The first Manager occupying the office of the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission is the living, breathing, sentient man or woman known by the appellation “Paul John Hansen.” Attestation regarding appointment of the said officer as the Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission is included with these Articles of Incorporation being filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Wyoming.

#### **B. Date of Inception**

The date of inception for T. J. Herbst Mission is on the eighth day of the sixth month of the one-thousand-nine-hundred-and-forty-fourth year of the common era. T. J. Herbst Mission is in continuous operation after the inception date, in either the common law form of association or in the statutorily recognized form of association.

#### **C. Service of Process**

When legal process needs service upon **T. J. Herbst Mission**, the only authorized recipient for such legal process is the Registered Agent of T. J. Herbst Mission. The posting location for the Registered Agent is: **Northern Sierra Services, 905 Broadway St STE 800, Sheridan, Wyoming 82801**. **T. J. Herbst Mission** cooperates fully in all matters under the cognizance of any court of competent jurisdiction.

**D. Acceptance of Duties**

I, the living, breathing, sentient being known by the appellation "Paul John Hansen," as the duly installed occupant of the office of Manager of T. J. Herbst Mission, do hereby accept the duties and obligations of this office, and pledge fair and impartial execution of these duties until such time as I am relieved of these duties by and through the above-described process.

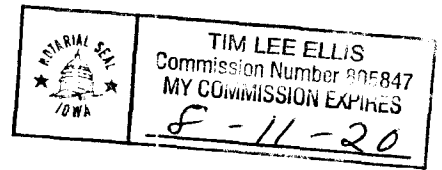

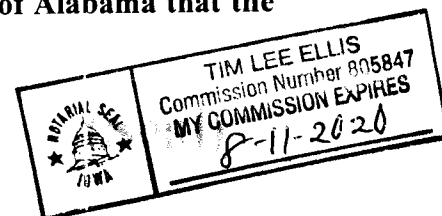
