MINUTE ENTRY

The Court has received and reviewed Defendant's Motion to Modify Conditions of Probation to Allow Contact filed October 2, 2022, State's Response to Defendant's Motion to Modify Conditions of Probation to Allow Contact filed October 27, 2022 and Crime Victim's Response and Objection to Defendant's Motion to Continue [Modify Conditions of Probation to Allow Contact] filed October 28, 2022.

Defendant is requesting to have regular contact with her son, the named victim and remove Term 19 from Defendant's probation terms. The State has deferred to the position of the victim. Victim's counsel has noted in his Response that victim, now over the age 18, is under a guardianship/conservatorship. The named Guardian/Conservator, Billy Zeek, has no objection to telephonic or virtual contact between Defendant and victim at victim's discretion. Victim, however, requests the probation officer still be involved with contact and requests the Court to deny the Motion.

**IT IS ORDERED** partially granting the Motion.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** Defendant may have contact both telephonically and virtually at the victim's discretion. The Court will not remove Term 19 at this time. The Adult Probation Officer may allow additional contact at their discretion.
